### **SERMON NOTES with ANSWERS**

Thesis: We can face any challenge once we are assured of God’s presence.

When God manifests His presence:

1. He is to be approached with reverence. Joshua 5:13

Application: Recognize “God-moments” and humbly respond to them with reverence.

2. He is not on a side, but we can be on His. Joshua 5:14

Application: Put God’s agenda before your own.

3. Recognize God as God. Joshua 5:14

Application: Tell others of the God you serve, rather than the religion you follow.

4. Worship Him. Joshua 5:14-15

Application: Worship God any way He leads you.
