What does "Missional Living" look like?

Our m<u>ission</u> is to see people t<u>ransformed</u> into the i<u>mage</u> of Christ.

The m<u>issional</u> church is the p<u>eople</u> of God p<u>artnering</u> with God in His r<u>edemptive</u> m<u>ission</u> in the world.
